

PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT: Recycling Program Update

<u>Drop Off Schedule:</u> MCSWC began accepting Recyclable Materials on a daily basis, Tuesday – Saturday, during regular business hours beginning MAY 26.

Phase 3: No. 1 and No. 3-7 plastics will be accepted beginning July 1st. In addition, MCSWC will begin collecting redeemable bottles and cans on July 1st.

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS: (DAILY- All Hours of Operation)

- Glass
- Plastic films
- Steel/Tin/Aluminum Cans & Containers
- Newsprint/Magazines/Paperback Books (NO Bindings/Binders or Hard Cover Books)
- Mixed Paper Cereal Boxes, Juice/Milk Cartons, Office Paper/Envelopes, Junk Mail
- #2 Colored/White Plastic (Laundry Detergent Bottles)
- #2 Natural Plastic (Milk/Juice/Water Jugs)
- Corrugated Cardboard & Brown Paper Bags
- Universal Waste (Lightbulbs & Lamps / TV's / Computers) See Gatehouse Attendant

Phase 4: MCSWC is working on re-opening the Reuse and Composting operations. MCSWC will provide additional notice regarding Phase 4 to alert the public of future changes.
