## **SWAP SHOP POLICY FOR 2023 SEASON**

## OPERATING HOURS: Tuesday – Saturday 9:00 A.M. - 2:00 P.M.

The swap shop is a part of the diversion practices that MCSWC supports. We accept items in good working order, not broken, something you would give a neighbor or a friend!

## NO ITEMS MAY BE LEFT AT THE SWAP SHOP AFTER HOURS!

# Mid-Coast Solid Waste is a Pay-As-You-Throw facility and because not all items left at the swap shop find a new home, we instituted a minimal fee scale for dropping off items at the Swap Shop to defer costs of final action if placed in the waste stream.

#### **CHARGES:**

\$1.00 Minimum charge fee for a single item is in effect for donations to Swap Shop (part of the \$1.00 minimum charge for an item brought to facility)

#### \$1.00 PER BOX or BAG of miscellaneous items brought to facility (three boxes misc. items = \$3.00)

- \$2.00 Bulky Items such as small desks, small/single chairs, shelving, filing cabinets, <u>carpets up to 5x8</u>
- \$4.00 LARGE BULKY ITEMS: COUCHES, Large Chairs (good shape/reusable any size (no sleeper couches) Large Furniture/Tables/Desks
  Carpeting over 5x8 is charged as a large bulky item

#### IF YOU ARE UNSURE OF AN ITEM, OR HAVE ANY ISSUES WITH DROP OFFS, PLEASE ASK FOR ASSISTANCE

**Regeneration Program** Accepts Lawn Mowers (cannot have any fluid in them including gas or oil) AND Bicycles that may need some basic TLC to get going again.

**FURNITURE**: All LARGE FURNITURE/DESKS/ TABLES/ BEDSETS /CABINETS (wood or metal) <u>must be</u> usable and structurally sound – **(Upholstered furniture must be in good clean condition**)

**CARPETING:** Small 4x6 or 5x8 carpets in good, clean condition and other larger carpets in good clean condition 8x10 or smaller can be left but the drop-off fee must be paid

# The following drop offs <u>not allowed</u> and some may require additional fees based on the current fee schedule to be paid.

**NO BULK DROPS – OF ANY KIND**: This includes Windows, Doors, Headboards, and Bed Frames (See Office/Foreman – Items must be paid for and placed in correct area of landfill) – See Foreman or Office

#### NO BROKEN ITEMS - TOOLS, LAMPS OR EQUIPMENT - NO ENCYCLOPEDIA SETS - NO PIANOS

**NO UNIVERSAL WASTE:** TV'S, COMPUTERS, LAPTOPS OR ELECTRONICS, NO PRINTERS WITH OR WITHOUT TONER, NO FAX MACHINES – **NO LIGHT BULBS OF ANY SHAPE OR SIZE** 

NO LIQUIDS or FLUIDS OF ANY KIND – PAINT, GASOLINE, OIL – NO CLEANING SUPPLIES MCSWC is a solid waste facility and cannot accept these items

NO DEHUMIDIFIERS/AIR CONDITIONERS, MICROWAVES OR REFRIDGERATORS

**NO HAZARDOUS MATERIAL** (Fertilizer/Insect Killer/Toxic Material of any kind: MCSWC is not licensed to accept this material

- NO LARGE APPLIANCES: WASHERS/ DRYERS/ DISWASHERS/STOVES
- NO BABY EQUIPMENT: CRIBS/CARSEATS OR STROLLERS
- NO LARGE CARPETS over the size of 8x10 : carpet must be clean and in good usable shape.
- NO MATTRESSES or PILLOWS (ANY BEDDING MUST BE IN VERY GOOD SHAPE)
- NO PROPANE GAS TANKS OR FIRE EXTINGUISHERS
- NO TIRES OR TIRES ON RIM/WHEEL
- NO TOILETS, TOILET SEATS OR TUBS
