Household hazardous waste (HHW) comes from leftover or used household products containing chemicals that if not disposed of properly, it can pose a threat to human health and the environment. Please see brochure for more information here:

Do you have HHW in your home such as paint, stains or glues sitting around in your garage? How about bags of unused yard chemicals or cans of vehicle fluids like anti-freeze?

If you do, then now is the time to get rid of them responsibly by bringing for proper disposal at our annual Household Hazardous Waste Collection. The collection day is for residents of the four towns that support our facility – Camden, Hope, Lincolnville and Rockport.

The event will take place between 1:00pm and 3:30 pm at 90 Union Street, Rockport, Maine. **MCSWC will not accept any material before or after the event.**

The amount of material you bring in will determine the fee paid. The fee is equal to \$16.00 per unit which = 5 gallons or 20 lbs. or a combination of material(s) equal to the same. The technician receiving the waste will determine the fee that is payable by cash or check.

Participants bringing items will remain in their vehicle. Place items to be unloaded in the back of the vehicle, preferably the trunk, pick-up truck bed, or on a utility trailer. The technicians will collect and handle the waste once you are on site.
